FAQ - Orgie Products

1. Are Orgie products safe to use during pregnancy, breastfeeding, or if one has a health condition?

Orgie Company does not recommend the use of its products during pregnancy, breastfeeding, or in cases of pre-existing health conditions.

Although our formulations do not present direct risks, pregnancy and breastfeeding involve significant physiological changes and increased sensitivity to substances that may come into contact with the body. These are delicate periods when many everyday products are temporarily avoided — such as hair dyes, alcohol, or certain cosmetics.

While there are no specific medical restrictions regarding sexual wellness cosmetics, some ingredients may not be suitable during pregnancy, breastfeeding, or certain health conditions. For this reason, we advise caution and strongly recommend consulting a healthcare professional before using any Orgie product during pregnancy, breastfeeding, or in cases of pre-existing health conditions.

2. Are Orgie products hypoallergenic or anti-allergic?

The term "anti-allergic" (or hypoallergenic) is often misunderstood. To officially classify a cosmetic as hypoallergenic, a product must undergo extensive clinical testing and long-term studies, which can take several years to complete. From initial formulation and pre-clinical testing to claim substantiation, it usually requires 1 to 3 years to build credible, defensible evidence that a product is truly hypoallergenic — and even then, this only means "formulated to minimize the risk of allergies", not "free from any allergic reaction."

These tests must demonstrate that the product does not cause allergic reactions in a representative sample of users — yet allergies remain highly individual and unpredictable.

It is also important to understand that a person who is not allergic to a substance today may develop an allergy to it in the future. For this reason, Orgie — like most responsible cosmetic brands — does not claim its products to be anti-allergic unless they have been properly tested for this specific purpose.

Sometimes, consumers refer to *skin reactions* or *sensitivities* when using the term "anti-allergic." In such cases, we clarify that any reaction depends on the individual body response to certain ingredient(s). This is why the precaution statements printed on the packaging of all Orgie products include, among others, the following mandatory advice:

- Do not apply on injured or irritated skin;
- Stop using the product in case of skin irritation.

All Orgie products are manufactured in compliance with European cosmetic regulations (Regulation (EC) No 1223/2009 and its subsequent amendments) and in accordance with Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP ISO 22716), ensuring quality, safety, and full regulatory compliance.

Orgie is committed to transparency, consumer safety, and regulatory excellence, ensuring that every product meets the highest EU standards.

3. What is the expiration date of Orgie products?

All Orgie products have a **shelf life of 3 years when unopened**, provided they are stored correctly — in a cool, dry place and away from direct sunlight or heat.

Once opened, each product has its own **period after opening (PAO)** — this is the small **open-jar symbol** printed on the back of the product box and label, followed by a number and the letter "M" (**for example**, *6M* means 6 months after opening).



The PAO indicates how long the product remains safe and effective after being first opened, assuming proper storage and handling.

The batch number and expiration date are also printed on the back of the product boxes and labels.

4. How long does it take for Orgie products to take effect, and how long do the effects last?

The time it takes for Orgie products to take effect — as well as how long the effects last — can vary from person to person. These variations are completely natural.

For this reason, there is **no fixed or universal timing** applicable to every user or product. While Orgie may provide **average estimations** for each item based on typical user experience, the **real response time and duration** will always depend on the product and on the individual body response to it.

In simple terms: different bodies, different responses. We encourage users to start with a small amount, observe their own reaction, and adjust usage according to personal comfort and desired intensity.

5. Are Orgie kissable/flavored products safe even though the packaging says "do not ingest"?

Yes. All Orgie products — including the *kissable* or *flavored* ones — are safe for their intended use. The precaution "do not ingest" appears on all products because Orgie cosmetics are not edible and are not meant to be swallowed as food.

Orgie flavored products are formulated with food-grade flavoring ingredients like any other brand, making them safe for kissing and licking, which may naturally result in minimal incidental ingestion. Such trace contact does not pose any risk when the product is used as intended.

Orgie's flavored products are **kissable and lickable** — **not edible**.

6. Is it safe to kiss or lick Orgie products such as Lube Tube water-based intimate gels and arousal gels that are not flavored?

Yes. Orgie's non-flavored water-based intimate gels and arousal gels are safe for incidental contact with the mouth, such as kissing or licking, when used as intended. Their formulations do not pose any risk if a small amount is ingested on kissing or licking, although the taste may not be pleasant since these products do not contain flavoring ingredients on their formula.

7. Do Intense Orgasm Hemp! and Lube Tube Flavors Cannabis contain CBD or THC?

No. Intense Orgasm Hemp! and Lube Tube Flavors Cannabis do not contain CBD or THC. These products use cosmetic-grade hemp-derived ingredients that deliver sensory and moisturizing benefits — without any psychoactive effects.

In other words: you will get high only on pleasure with them!

8. Wow! The Buccal Sprays line and *Oral Ease Deepthroat – Mouth and Throat Sprays* include the warnings "do not ingest" and "for external use" in their precautions, but these products are applied inside the mouth. How should this be understood?

Orgie Wow! buccal spray line and Oral Ease Deepthroat Spray are for external use only. These products are designed for topical application inside the mouth and throat area and should not be swallowed. As with mouthwash, some residual ingestion may occur during normal use. This is expected and poses no risk, but intentional ingestion must be avoided.

As reference, the same precautions apply to mouthwash and toothpaste, which are also cosmetic products intended for topical use inside the mouth. Toothpaste is not meant to be eaten, and mouthwash is not meant to be drunk.

That is why cosmetic regulations require the warnings "External use" and "Do not ingest" to appear on the product packaging.

9. What is the vibrating ingredient in Orgie's products?

The ingredient responsible for the vibrating effect is Jambu extract, a plant cultivated in northern Brazil, particularly in the states of Amazonas and Pará.

Native to the Amazon rainforest, Jambu has long been part of the culinary tradition of these regions, where farms are dedicated to its cultivation.

10. Why does Orgie *Lube Tube, All-Natural,* and *Orgie Bio water-based* lubricants say "for external use" if they are meant to be used internally?

Orgie Lube Tube, All-Natural, and Orgie Bio are cosmetic water-based intimate gels with lubricant effect, made in full compliance with European regulations and formulated for safe and gentle for intimate contact, exactly as each of our water-based intimate gels are intended.

Brands that produce cometic intimate gels with lubricating effect cannot label or market them as "lubricants", since that term is reserved for "medical device" lubricants made by the pharmaceutical industry — such as lubricants for medical or therapeutic purposes, and sexual wellness brands that have "medical device" personal lubricants manufactured by pharmaceutical industry. For instance, most (if not all) Pjur branded lubricants.

11. Why does Orgie products *Tighten and She Spot* say "for external use" if they seem to be used internally?

Tighten and She Spot shall be applied externally, around the vulva and clitoral area.

During use — whether through intercourse, masturbation, or with sex toys — Tighten may naturally reach the vaginal channel and She Spot reaches the G-Spot.

This is completely safe and part of normal use. The formulas suitable for contact with mucous membranes.

For a faster or more intense effect, you may apply a very small amount at the entrance of the vaginal canal, if desired.

12. Are Orgie products compatible with condoms and sex toys?

Our arousal gels and intimate gels with lubricating effect have not been specifically tested for compatibility with condoms or sex toys. However, we have never received any reports of incompatibility from consumers or partners.

Please note that Sexy Therapy and Tantric sensual massage body oils are not compatible with condoms or sex toys, due to their oil-based formulation, which can weaken latex and certain materials used in toys.

Whenever using any intimate product, we recommend checking the material of your condom or toy and performing a small compatibility test before use.

13. Can I mix and match Orgie products?

Absolutely! You can let your imagination run free and combine different Orgie products to create new sensations and experiences.

The only golden rule is: do not combine two vibrating products at the same time.

Orgie's vibrating formulas are very effective — using more than one together may cause an intense warming or tingling — can feel like a harmless but unpleasant burning sensation.

14. What is the recommended dosage for Orgie's vibrating products? And what should I do if I feel a burning sensation from using too much or combining two vibrating products?

Orgie recommends starting with one pump dose of any vibrating product — or one drop in the case of *Orgasm Drops Vibe!* — and then adjusting the amount according to what feels most pleasurable and comfortable for you.

If you experience an intense or burning sensation due to overdosage or combining two vibrating products, simply wash the area with warm (not hot) water and mild soap, then apply a small amount of a neutral intimate gel or lubricant to soothe the skin.

The sensation is harmless and temporary, but using the right amount ensures the best and most enjoyable experience.
